

MBLAC Club Uniform Policy



1. Scope

Murray Bridge Little Athletics Club (MBLAC) is an affiliated club of South Australian Little Athletics Association INC (SALAA). MBLAC uniform must comply with the requirements of SALAA Club Uniform Regulations. Unapproved uniform items will not be permitted to be worn at SALAA competitions and may result in athletes being disqualified. MBLAC uniform is registered with and approved by SALAA.

2. Purpose

This policy is intended to ensure that MBLAC athletes are informed of the MBLAC uniform that has been approved by SALAA and to encourage inclusion at local meets, regional and SALAA state competitions. MBLAC athletes should be encouraged to wear their uniform with pride and a sense of belonging to the MBLAC. MBLAC uniform is encouraged to be worn at all promotional opportunities as a representation of the MBLAC club.

3. Policy

Uniforms are available from online ordering through printcity.net.au. Older style uniforms and sun smart hats are available from the uniform officer.

It is optimal that athletes are wearing full MBLAC uniform by their fourth (4th) week after registration. Special considerations must be discussed with the president and/or recorder prior to the start of the meet otherwise attendance and results will not be recorded.

MBLAC uniform consists of:

1. MBLAC registered double blue shirt with SALAA sponsor and age group (front top left), and registration number (front bottom centre) badges attached. *Coles sponsor (front top right) can still be worn but it is no longer required by SALAA.*
2. MBLAC singlets may be worn by athletes in U12 - U17 age groups with badges attached as per 1.0.
3. Tiny Tots can either wear MBLAC registered shirt or plain light blue shirt with badges attached as per 1.0.
4. Plain black, either above knee or full-length sports leggings.
5. Appropriate running or cross trainer footwear is compulsory for all events otherwise disqualification will occur.
6. 7mm long spikes are only permitted for U11 - U17 age groups subject to event rules.
7. Appropriate sun smart hats are advised to be worn before, between and after events.

4. Responsibilities

Club Committee are responsible for:

- Registering and having a SALAA approved MBLAC uniform available for purchase by members of the MBLAC club.
- Providing all MBLAC athletes with age group, sponsor and registration number badges once registered with the MBLAC club each season.
- Informing all registered members of MBLAC of the approved uniform requirements for local, regional and SALAA state competitions.

All athletes, parents/guardians are required to:

- Follow the MBLAC Club Uniform Policy
- Seek special consideration leniency from the president and/or recorder if unable to comply with MBLAC Club Uniform Policy by forth (4th) week post registration with the MBLAC club.
- Seek replacement age, sponsor and/or registration numbers from the registrar in case of loss or damage.
