MBLAC Club Dog Free Policy



1. Purpose

Murray Bridge Little Athletics Club (MBLAC) is committed to providing its registered members and their families, committee, coaches, officials, and volunteers with a safe environment in which to meet.

2. Scope

This policy relates to all sites under the organisation and control of MBLAC.

3. Policy

For the safety of all registered members and their families, committee, coaches, officials, and volunteers of MBLAC, dogs are not allowed to be brought onto the site during a MBLAC meet or organised activity.

4. Responsibilities

Club Committee are responsible for:

- Having a Dog-free policy in place that covers MBLAC Club meets and MBLAC organised activities.
- Informing all registered members of MBLAC of the MBLAC Club Dog-free Policy.
- If a dog is brought onto the site during a MBLAC meet or organised activity, the president and delegated committee member/s are required to address the owner, inform them of the Dog-free policy and kindly ask them to remove the dog from the site until the meet /organised activity is completed.

All athletes, parents/guardians, committee, coaches, officials, and volunteers are required to:

- Follow the MBLAC Club Dog-free Policy.
- Respect the right of other athletes, parents/guardians, committee, coaches, and volunteers to enjoy a safe environment.
- Comply with the instructions from the president and committee members.
